The level of management control required for these sources will be monitored through our supplier review process.
- Generator Power will not knowingly deal or support any company or business involved in slavery or human trafficking.
- Endeavour to run our business with integrity and transparency, including but not limited to, relationships with employees, customers, suppliers, competitors, the government and the public.
- Not sanction corrupt behaviour under any circumstances, nor engage in Slavery or human trafficking in any of our activities.
- Commit to conducting our operations in compliance with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements and global environmental initiatives.
- Benchmark ourselves against best practice standards and seek to pursue a best practice approach wherever practical.
- The Directors and Senior Management of Generator Power Ltd shall take responsibility for implementing this policy statement and all of its objectives and shall provide adequate resources and investment to ensure that Slavery and Human Trafficking is not taking place within the company and any of its supply chain.
